**The outfitter and client agree to the following:**

- All fees payable by the client to the outfitter for the services to be provided are to be paid in US funds. The hunt price and incidentals are based on US funds, providing the US dollar is at least at par with the CDN dollar; should the US dollar fall below the CDN dollar, the hunt price and all incidentals will be valued in CDN funds. If the US dollar value falls below the CDN dollar the exchange loss is the responsibility of the client. Charges for licenses and tags are not included in the hunt price and are subject to change. Tags are invoiced 4-6 weeks prior to the hunt date. They are due upon receipt. If the client is successful, government royalties are payable before the client leaves the camp. They are to be paid in cash or travelers checks. The client agrees and understands that they are not "trophy fees."
- All payments are non-refundable, but are transferable (with the exception of tags and licenses). Hunt transfer fees will be charged for either transferring the hunt to another year and/or to another party. If they have been issued they are non-transferable and non-refundable. It is the client's responsibility to find a replacement hunter. If, for any reason, the client fails to arrive in the camp as scheduled, no compensation or adjustments will be due and payable by the outfitter. We recommend that you, the client, obtain cancellation insurance. Information in regards to cancellation insurance is available.
- The client understands and agrees that if an animal is wounded by them during the hunt and it cannot be found, they will not be permitted to hunt another animal of the same species unless it is determined by the outfitter that the wound is non-fatal and that the animal will survive.
- The client agrees to obey the reasonable directions and instructions of the outfitter, its employees or contractors at all times. The contract may be terminated by the outfitter if, in their opinion, the client is being unsafe, unlawful or acting in an unreasonable manner prior to or during the hunt. The client will not be refunded any money already paid to the outfitter.
- The client represents and warrants to the outfitter that their physical and mental condition is such that they are capable of making the hunt and withstanding the environmental conditions that may exist including - but not limited to - exposure to the elements, diverse weather conditions, isolation, rugged conditions and travelling on horseback or by boat. If, in the opinion of the outfitter, the client is physically incapable of withstanding the hunt, the outfitter will terminate the hunt and the client will not be refunded any money already paid.
- Unless specifically provided as an addendum to the contract, the client agrees that the outfitter makes no presentation or warranty to the client in respect to the operations and services to be provided. The outfitter makes no guarantee that game animals will be harvested or seen by the client. The hunt is conducted under the tenets of fair chase.
- The outfitter is not considered in default of the contract for reasons out of their reasonable control such as forces of nature, regulation changes, allocations or quota changes, law or by any changes constituted by civil or military authorities, fuel shortages, labor difficulties, roads closed either by a road block or wash out, forest fires, floods, weather conditions making it, in the outfitters opinion, unreasonable or impossible to hunt wildlife, lack of mode of transportation, failure of machinery or equipment, failure to attain government-required licensing, or act of God. The outfitter reserves the right to transfer the hunt either to another location or alternate date at their discretion.
- For the duration of the hunt, services provided by the outfitter to the client shall include: food and lodging, guides, transportation within guide area, field preparation and skinning of trophies, transportation to and from the airport/hotel in \_\_\_\_\_ CITY \_\_\_\_\_ PROVINCE/TERRITORY \_\_\_\_\_. First and last days of scheduled trip are used for transportation to and from camps. The hunt begins and ends at base camp. Transportation of trophies and meat are to base camp only. Cut, wrapping, freezing and transportation to the meat cutters is the responsibility of the client. Taxidermy is not included in hunt price. Airport pick up and drop off times are times are determined by the outfitter's schedule, any deviations from that established schedule are not the responsibility of the outfitter and will be subject to third party charges.
- Additional charges for add-on animals and trophy fees are due and payable to the outfitter in cash or travelers checks upon arrival in camp and will be held in trust. In regards to trophy fees (grizzly bears) if no animal is taken, trophy fees will be returned to the client at the conclusion of the hunt. Declarations must be signed by the client prior to leaving the base camp.
- This contract shall ensure to the benefit of both parties and shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their receptive successors, heirs or beneficiaries if any. The contract is non-transferable. This contract supersedes all previous understandings and agreements, whether verbal or written and constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the outfitter and the client with respect to the subject matter hereof.
- The client gives permission to release their personal information and photos to the Guide Outfitters Association of BC. The information will not be sold or given to any other third parties. The client agrees that their information and pictures may be given to the Guide Outfitters Association of BC.
- The client is aware and agrees that the applicable law is that of OUTFITTER'S PROVINCE/TERRITORY, Canada.

**ASSUMPTION OF RISK and RELEASE FROM LIABILITY**

I, the client, hereby acknowledge that the hunting trip, fishing trip, sightseeing trip, camping trip, photograph tour, trap line adventure, snowmobile tour or other guided tour that I am participating in under the arrangements of OUTFITTER NAME, its employees, agents and associates. I understand that there are risks and danger inherent to hunting and wilderness travel, including - but not limited to - hazards of travelling by motorized vehicles, horseback, airplane and/or boats, hazards of being in possession of firearms and ammunition, hazards of being exposed to the elements of wilderness areas and hazards arising from accidents, acts of God, illness or forces of nature.

Accordingly, in consideration of OUTFITTER NAME accepting my application for guided wilderness hunting and/or fishing, I, the client agree for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, as follows:

- To assume any and all risk, danger and hazards inherent in wildlife hunting, fishing or wilderness travel, horseback riding, ATV riding and/or travelling by airplane or boat.
- To waive any and all claims I have now and in the future have against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue, the outfitter and its servants, agents, employees or any personal injury, due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence on the part of the outfitter, its servant agents or employees.
- To indemnify and hold harmless the outfitter and its servants agents or employees from any claims or demands which might be made against the outfitter arising out of or in consequence of my attendance or participating in guided wilderness hunting, fishing, sightseeing camping, photography, trap line adventures, snowmobile tour or any other activity the outfitter offers.

I, the client, further acknowledge that:

- I will conduct myself in the manner expected of a responsible outdoorsman at all times. This includes - but is not limited to - obeying and respecting deferral and provincial laws, local fishing/hunting guidelines, traditions or customs. I will obey the instruction or direction of the outfitter, its servants, employees and/or agents. I acknowledge that failure to do so may result in immediate expulsion from the guided trip, reporting to conservation and/or police authorities and forfeiture of my fees.
- Wildlife hunting and fishing are unpredictable sporting adventures. As such, I understand that any itinerary, schedule and/or information by the outfitter is a guideline and not a contract. Factors such as weather, season variations in animal population, mechanical breakdown, medical emergencies, and/or acts of God may affect the success of my trip. I acknowledge that I am responsible for supplying my own firearms, ammunition, fishing rods, tackle, clothing, footwear, rain gear, sleeping bags, pillows and personal toiletries, alcohol and tobacco.

I, THE CLIENT, HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT AND AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING IT I AM AFFECTING MY LEGAL RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES OF MYSELF AND MY EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS AND ASSIGNS AGAINST OUTFITTER NAME AND ITS SERVANTS AND EMPLOYEES.

THE APPLIABLE LAW SHALL BE THAT OF PROVINCE/TERRITORY, CANADA.
