



## Wilderness Guiding & Wrangling Program Equipment List

**Students will be required to bring the following items for the program:**

1. Prescription medicine for the entire 30 day program (if needed). Please inform NWCC of medical conditions, including allergies.
2. Fishing license – must obtain freshwater license before going to ranch
3. Cough drops, Tylenol/ Ibuprofen, allergy medication, epi-pen (if needed)
4. Good quality sleeping bag (rated to minimum 0 degrees)
5. Thin foamy (back packing pad)
6. Pillow and slip case
7. Good quality rain gear and warm jacket
8. Day pack / back pack
9. Hiking boots, camp shoes, rubber boots, sandals/flip-flops
10. 7-8 changes of clothes, including 3 or 4 pairs of pants (wool pants if you have them), 1 pair hiking pants, 6 pair hiking socks (wool preferred)
11. Personal toiletries (toothbrush & paste, shampoo, deodorant, razor, cream, brush)
12. Towel & face cloth
13. Flashlight and extra batteries
14. Watch- alarm clock
15. Leatherman-style tool and sharp pocket knife
16. Leather gloves
17. Hat / toque
18. 2 lighters or waterproof matches
19. Sunglasses, sunscreen & bug repellent
20. Pens, pencils, notebook, 3 ring binder with paper

**These items are recommended (but not essential):**

1. Fishing rod and tackle
2. Camera and extra batteries
3. Binoculars
4. Spotting Scope
5. Back Pack Tent if you have but not necessary
6. Gators
7. GPS & Compass
8. Cell phone (optional), if you want to make calls home

**Do not bring the following items:**

1. Firearms or archery equipment
2. Jewellery (rings, necklaces)
3. Drugs or alcohol. This is a zero tolerance camp setting.

The camp is equipped with a washer and dryer. Students' laundry is done on an alternating basis. All food will be provided, with students helping with preparation & clean up. There is cell phone service. You must bring your own cell phone if you want to make personal calls. There will be very limited opportunity to get supplies from town. Students are expected to bring everything they need to stay at the ranch site for 30 days.
